- 1970, Began study of Cornet at age 9 and performing with the Washington Grade School Band.
- 1973, Began study & performing on Bass Guitar at age 12.
- 1974, Began study & performing on Button (diatonic) Accordion at age 13 performing with Verne Meisner.
- 1975, Featured on first recording with Verne Meisner "Autumn Leaves" and won 1st place 2 years at the Chicago & Milwaukee Button Box Competitions at age 14 & 15.
- 1976, Performing full time at age 15 with the Verne Meisner Orchestra and the New Frontier Dance Group. Began study of Tuba at age 15 performing with the Whitewater High School Band.
